Exchequer (Ilse) - \$11,000

- b. Kingdom will notify the Reservationist to instruct the MEMBERS authorized to do the transactions that they can download the app to their phone/tablet/laptop.
- c. A Kingdom Representative will come and train the MEMBERS doing **PayPal Here**. This would most likely be AT THE EVENT, or some other Event where the training can be held.
- d. After the event, Kingdom will generate a report of the transactions and send a copy with a check to the reservationist
- e. Close down Group access to PayPal Here
